The Curriculum for the Veda Patashala

Vedas are the sacred roots of Indian heritage and culture. They are revered to be the divine life force from the cosmos, which confers peace, prosperity and well being of humanity. Over the years, the Vedas have passed from generation to generation by oral renditions. It is our bounden duty and responsibility to protect and sustain the Vedas.

The courses are conducted by adopting the syllabus prescribed by the Patashala.

The syllabus consists of two parts

- (i) Krishna Yajur Vedam and
- (ii) Sanskrit and Shastram. These subjects are handled independently.

The subjects under the Krishna Yajur Vedam taught to the students consists of

- Taitriya Samhita, Tatriya Brahmanam, Mantra Prasnam
- Taitriya Aranyam and Katakam.

Under the subject Sanskrit and Shastram, they are taught

- Raghu Vamsam
- Laghu Siddhanta Kaumudi
- Sundara Kandam
- Bhagawat Geetha and
- Rigveda Bhashya Bhoomika

During the next three years, they are brought to a higher level of Vedic studies equal to the graduation level.

During the final or the last three years, the studies are taken to a still higher level of Vedic education, equal to post graduation. During this period they learn "Jata" and "Ghanam".

Examinations are conducted annually. The students undergo periodical examinations every year as per the directive of the Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam.
